Village of Homer Glen to Conduct Resident Survey

Homer Glen, (February 24, 2017)

At the February 22, 2017 Village Board meeting, the Village Board approved an agreement with the National Research Center to conduct the National Citizen Survey (NCS). The Village of Homer Glen intends to use the survey results to help guide the Village Board in future decision-making and strategic planning initiatives.

The National Citizen Survey is a set of customizable questions intended to measure eight aspects of community livability: community engagement, education and enrichment, recreation and wellness, economy, built environment, natural environment, safety and mobility. This scientific survey has been used by more than 300 communities in 45 states and is endorsed by the International City/County Management Association (ICMA).

“The Village Board wanted to have an understanding of how the residents feel about the current state of our community and the services provided by the Village of Homer Glen. It’s important that the Village Board and I continue to listen to what the residents want and expect from their Community,” stated Mayor George Yukich.

1,500 households throughout the Village will be randomly chosen to participate in the approximately 16 question survey. Selected households will receive a pre-notification postcard in the mail in mid to late April and the survey will arrive in the mail shortly thereafter.
