AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE PLACEMENT
OF TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES (NO PARKING SIGNS) ON OAKWOOD DRIVE

WHEREAS, the Illinois Municipal Code and the Illinois Vehicle Code Authorizes the Village of Homer Glen to regulate and prohibit parking on public streets and roads under their jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the safety of the residents of the Village of Homer Glen to prohibit motor vehicle parking at all times on certain hereinafter designated portions of Oakwood Drive; and

WHEREAS, the result of the aforesaid investigation by Robinson Engineering demonstrates that there is sufficient justification for the installation of No Parking signs within the limits of the traffic circle on Oakwood Drive.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF HOMER GLEN, WILL COUNTY, ILLINOIS, THAT:

Section 1: Recitals – The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated into this Ordinance No. as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2: Placement of No Parking Signs- From and after the effective date of this Ordinance, at the east and west limits of the Oakwood Drive traffic circle.

Section 3: Violation and Penalty - The operator, owner or lessee or any motor vehicle, or any person, firm, corporation or business entity who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$100.00 and not more than \$250.00 for each separate offense.

Section 4: Severability - The various portions of this Ordinance are hereby expressly declared to be severable, and the invalidity of any such portion of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other portions of this Ordinance, which shall be enforced to the fullest extent possible.

Section 5: Repealer - All ordinances or portions of ordinances previously passed or adopted by the Village of Homer Glen that conflict with or are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 6: Effective Date - This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
