AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS AND THE
PLACEMENT OF TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES ON OAKWOOD DRIVE/OAKWOOD
COURT WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF HOMER GLEN

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of 625 ILCS 5/11-604, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Homer Glen may by ordinance establish absolute maximum speed limits for all streets within the corporate limits of the Village and which are not under the jurisdiction of or maintained by the Illinois Department of Transportation, the Illinois State Toll Highway Authority or the Will County Highway Department; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of 625 ILCS 5/11-304, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Homer Glen may by ordinance authorize the placement of traffic control devices for all streets within the corporate limits of the Village;

WHEREAS, utilizing criteria established by the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT), the Village of Homer Glen has undertaken an engineering study and investigation concerning speed limits on Oakwood Drive and Oakwood Court between Golden Oak Drive and Parker Rd ; and

WHEREAS, upon the basis of the engineering study and investigation the Village has determined that a maximum speed limit on Oakwood Drive and Oakwood Court between Golden Oak Drive and Parker Rd should be 20 miles per hour; and

WHEREAS, the results of the aforesaid study and investigation demonstrate satisfaction of the aforementioned IDOT criteria sufficient to justify the reduction of speed limits in the area, described below.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF HOMER GLEN, WILL COUNTY, ILLINOIS, THAT:

Section 1: Recitals – The foregoing recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2: Establishment of Absolute Maximum Speed Limit and Placement of Speed Limit Signs- from and after the effective date of this Ordinance, the absolute maximum speed limit on Oakwood Drive and Oakwood Court between Golden Oak Drive and Parker Road shall be 20 miles per hour. Speed limit signs shall be placed on Oakwood Drive and Oakwood Court approximately 150 feet from the intersections at Golden Oak Drive and Parker Road.

Section 3: Severability - The various portions of this Ordinance are hereby expressly declared to be severable, and the invalidity of any such portion of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other portions of this Ordinance, which shall be enforced to the fullest extent possible.

Section 4: Repealer - All ordinances or portions of ordinances previously passed or adopted by the Village of Homer Glen that conflict with or are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5: Penalty – Any person violating this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$750.00.

Section 6: Effective Date - This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
