Village of Homer Glen's Annual Road Resurfacing Program Underway

Homer Glen, (August 3, 2012)

The Village's annual roadway resurfacing program began today, August 3rd. Funded by the Village's General and Motor Fuel Tax funds, Homer Glen's roadway resurfacing program is designed to provide the community with safe roads. Each year, roads within the community are evaluated to determine which need preventative maintenance such as patching, crack-filling or complete surface replacement.

Village of Homer Glen's Mayor Jim Daley stated "A strong and stable roadway system is important to maintain property values and ensure safe travel." "In Homer Glen, our streets are carefully monitored by the Homer Township Roadway District and they do a terrific job each year repairing and resurfacing the Village's roads," concluded the Mayor. Mayor Daley would also like to remind motorists to stay alert, use caution and abide by all traffic regulations when driving through construction zones.
