
This letter is to formalize the agreement between the Village of Homer Glen (“Village”) and the Forest Preserve District of Will County (“District”) with respect to certain restoration, monitoring and maintenance requirements relating to the areas of disturbance depicted on “Exhibit A” within the Fiddymont Creek Preserve. Those areas total approximately 8.2 acres (collectively the “Areas of Disturbance”).

In consideration of a one-time payment of \$65,620.00 by the Village of Homer Glen to the District, which amount will be paid in full on or before April 1, 2020, the District shall restore the Areas of Disturbance previously damaged by the Village during the installation of the sewer pursuant to License 18-03 (License). District restoration may include regrading of the streambank, installation of erosion control blankets and streambank plugs, and other actions determined necessary by the District (collectively the “Work”). The Village of Homer Glen shall have no obligation to perform the Work. Both the Village and District agree that this payment and restorations previously made by the Village will satisfy all of the Village’s obligation to restore the “License Area and Temporary Construction License Area” for impacts caused during the installation of the sewer project per paragraph 11 of the License.

This agreement does not change, modify, or replace the terms and conditions of the License. Any future action by the District or the Village (including, but not limited to its contractors and subcontractors, and others acting on behalf of the Village) taken pursuant to the License remains subject to the terms and conditions of the License. Therefore, per paragraph 8 of the License, the Village must secure a Special Use Permit from the District prior to work within the License Area. Furthermore, the Village continues to be responsible for any future restoration work as required under paragraph 12 of the License.

The persons signing this Agreement on behalf of the Village and the District each represent that he or she has authority to enter into this Agreement on behalf of the party for whom he or she is signing.




