- FOR ON-LINE APPLICATIONS, click here. If your last name begins with letters:
  - o A through M file your claim on Sundays, Tuesdays, Thursdays.
  - N through Z file your claim online on Mondays, Wednesday, Fridays.
  - \*Saturdays for those who missed their application window.
- FOR PHONE APPLICATIONS, call (800) 244-5631. If your last name begins with letters:
  - o A through M call between 7:30am 6pm on Tuesdays and Thursdays.
  - N through Z call between 7:30am 6pm on Mondays and Wednesdays.

## **Restore Illinois**

**Q:** Can the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) give further clarification on how the regions were developed in the Restore Illinois plan and how the IDPH Districts will factor into the plan (if at all)?

**A:** IDPH has 11 Emergency Medical Services Regions that have traditionally guided its statewide public health work. For the purposes of the Restore Illinois plan, from those 11, four health regions were established: Northeast Illinois, North-Central Illinois, Central Illinois and Southern Illinois.

**A:** According to the Restore Illinois plan, cinemas and theaters can open in <a href="Phase 4">Phase 4</a> with capacity limits and IDPH approved safety guidance. Please continue to check the DPH website to determine which phase your region is in.
