

HOMER GLEN TRANSPORTATION PLAN Q&A ADDENDUM

Does the Village have an anticipated schedule or date when deliverables should be completed?

Project should be completed before the end of the year.

Does the Village have an ADA transition plan?

The Village does not currently have an ADA transition plan. Our public works department does have a list of ADA transitions they are working on as requested by Will County and that list will be updated and made available to the selected firm.

Does the Village have a PASER or other roadway inventory system already established?

The Village will provide previous pavement evaluation surveys to the selected firm. The most recent was completed in 2019 and will be updated to reflect all roadways that have been paved as part of our resurfacing program since 2019. This will all be made available to the selected firm.

Does the Village have an estimated budget allotment for this Plan update?

The Village has a budget of \$150,000 for this plan update.

Additional clarification on item 4.c regarding pavement evaluation and the PASER system:

The intent for the pavement evaluation is to perform a visual inspection of the Homer Glen roadways and rate the roads on more of a 'per-street' basis on a scale from 1-10 consistent with the rating scale in the PASER manual. Once the streets are rated, that information would be put onto a map which will show roadway/street condition throughout the Village. As stated above, existing roadway condition maps and additional resurfacing information would be provided to the selected firm.
