Re: Close Interval & Depth of Cover Survey

Dear Neighbor:

Chicap Pipe Line Company (Chicap) will be conducting a close interval and depth of cover survey on its existing pipeline running through, or in close proximity to, your property. The survey activities are scheduled to start in early March 2026 at Patoka Station in Vernon, Illinois, and will continue north for several weeks along multiple pipeline routes.

The survey crew (Titan Corrosion) and project inspector (Northern Inspection Services) all contracted by Chicap, will be walking along the pipeline route and you may notice them on your property. The crew will consist of 3 to 4 people collecting corrosion data on the surface area along the pipeline route with electronic devices as well as depth of cover data. As part of this survey, a very small gauge, red coated wire will be trailing the crew for a period of time. Once your section has been surveyed, the wire will be picked up in a timely manner. The crew will be working Monday through Saturday; no work will be done on Sunday.

In order to accurately survey the pipeline, the crew may need to go through gates or cross fences to access fields and/or pastures while following the pipeline route. All gates will be closed after use, and no debris will be left on the right-of-way after the survey has been completed.
